### Cornell-Lake Holcombe Regionals in Athens

The Knights track and field teams both came in fifth place at regionals. The boys team will have nine traveling on to sectionals and the girls team has 13.

The girls 4x800 meter relay team of senior Anna Burlingame, junior Thia Moreen, and sophomores Kayla Vavra and Lexi Moussette, placed first, while the 4x400 team of Moreen, Vavra, Moussette and sophomore Elizabeth Sproul took second place.

In girls field events, sophomore Courtney Lundmark took second in the discus, while sophomore Sara Stender placed third in triple jump.

The boys had top three finishes with junior Eric Nedland leading the team with a second place finish in the boys pole vault.

Also placing second for boys was senior Jesse Knitter in the 300-meter hurdles, and junior Preston Strzok, who

The Knights have Nedland advancing to state, after he placed third in the pole vault. Nedland vaulted 12 feet and 3 inches, which places him about tenth out of 16 competitors at state.

The girls 4x800 meter relay, consisting of Burlingame, Moreen, Moussette and Vavra improved their school record time by 21 seconds and finished fifth. The team missed state by 4 seconds.

The girls 4x400 meter relay of Sproul, Moussette, Vavra and Moreen also missed state by only .7 seconds, but improved their school record time by 4 seconds, finishing fifth.

Knights head coach Jacob Ebner said the only other athlete to place was Lundmark in the discus, finishing eighth. Everyone else on the teams placed ninth or lower.
